

Valdez City School District is consistently rated as one of the top districts in the state of Alaska. Currently, there is a graduation rate of 89.58%, and an average attendance rate of 93% among students. The district consists of three brick and mortar schools (an elementary, middle, and high school), a home school program, and has an enrollment of 651 students for the 2016-2017 school year. There is a small teacher to student ratio, so incoming staff should be prepared to make the most out of available contact time with students. High quality staff members contribute to a collaborative environment and help to make the district the success that it is.
