Legislative Lawsuit

- Dedicated Funds Clause (Article 9, Section 7, Alaska Constitution)
 - Constitutional Separation of Powers
 - Forward Funding of Education
 - One time supplemental funding
- Constitutional Questions must necessarily be heard by the Alaska Supreme Court

Legislative Testimony Increasing District Participation

Reasons for low turnout:

- Takes too much time
- Not enough understanding of the issue
- Not comfortable speaking publicly (even on the phone)
- Its the Superintendent's job

AASB's new system makes testifying simple, inclusive, and less time consuming!



Testimony by Text How it Works



House or Senate schedules a hearing to gather public testimony on a key education-related bill.



AASB sends an ALERT text to your mobile phone (and email) with a link to a brief online survey about the bill.
