NOTES FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Keeping with the theme of attendance, I want to highlight issues we know that we have with getting and keeping kids in school. Most of our attendance issues are not due to a lack of value or care for education or lack of family engagement, nor a disconnect between parents and children. We know that people in our community value education, know where their kids are, and care that they are attending school regularly.

Our primary issues with attendance seem to be related to non-school-based activities and family time. Please note that school-based extra-curricular activities (like Basketball, Crosscountry, MusicFest, and Regional Science Fair in Fairbanks) are not counted as absences. Please consider how family trips and other activities may impact your child's education. Also consider what impact such absences may have on peers, the classroom, and your child's teacher (as teachers always want to make sure students get missed content or have to adjust plans when there are many students gone at one time).

There is work being done with school schedules to help reduce the impact of some activities. You will always have to assess the importance of family priorities, but please consider scheduling optional vacations at times that reduce the impact on your child's time in school.
