

2019 ALASKA SCHOOL CLIMATE AND CONNECTEDNESS SURVEY ©

Information

The School Climate and Connectedness Survey (SCCS) is a voluntary statewide online survey that measures how staff, students, and families view their school climate, how connected students feel to adults and their peers, social and emotional learning, and observed student risk behaviors at school or school events. It is available to all Alaska School Districts.

Surveys

In 2019, there are two student surveys, one staff survey, and a family survey available to districts:

- **Student Grade 6-12 Survey**
- **Staff Survey:** Open to all staff in participating schools who have contact with students.
- **Student Grade 3-5 Survey**
- **Family Survey:** Open to families of students in participating schools.

Registration Deadline: November 12, 2019

Survey Window: Districts select a two-week window from January 18- March 22 2018.

District Coordinator (Each district selects one district coordinator who):

- Serves as primary liaison for the survey between the district and AASB.
- Uses online survey platform to:
 - Confirm participating schools.
 - Identify key district and school contacts to receive survey communications.
 - Monitor survey progress (in conjunction with AASB).
- Fields questions for district and school contacts during the survey.
- Ensures that survey instructions and other communications are distributed and understood by survey contacts.
