ABOUT THE PROGRAM

What is the Alaska Communications Summer of Heroes program?

- Summer of Heroes is an annual program that recognizes five outstanding young heroes, plus one hero from the Employee Program, who are making a difference in their local communities in Alaska.
- Now in its 11th year, Summer of Heroes aims to raise awareness and support for youth development programs throughout the state, such as those provided by Boys & Girls Clubs Alaska, the official nonprofit partner for Summer of Heroes.
- Through the pandemic, Boys & Girls Clubs throughout Alaska are continuing to serve youth in non-traditional methods and they could use our support now, more than ever.

Who can be nominated for the youth recognition program?

A hero can be any Alaska resident between the ages of 6 and 18 who is making a positive difference in his or her community. Examples include, but are not limited to, the following types of efforts:

- Volunteering or raising funds for a cause,
- Making a difference in school through education or sports,
- Making a significant contribution to his or her community,
- Considering others' needs before their own, or
- Inspiring others to get involved.

This year, a hero's efforts may have come to light during the pandemic when he/she took action to help others in the community during a challenging time.

When does the Summer of Heroes program start and end?

• The nomination period for hero candidates runs from May 10 – July 2, 2021.

What is the nomination process for the Summer of Heroes program?

Starting May 10, nominations can be submitted one of the following two ways:

- Online: Visit the <u>Summer of Heroes website</u> (<u>www.alaskacommunications.com/summerofheroes</u>) and follow the instructions for completing and submitting the nomination form.
- Print or in-person: Obtain a hard-copy nomination form from any Boys & Girls Clubs Alaska Clubhouse or by downloading the PDF from the Summer of Heroes website. Complete the form and submit it in-person at a Boys & Girls Clubs – Alaska Clubhouse or via email to <u>SummerofHeroes@alaskacommunications.com</u>.

All nominations must be received by July 2.

How will the heroes be recognized?

The five heroes, plus one hero from the Employee Program, will receive:

- a \$1,500 scholarship through the Alaska 529 College Savings Plan, and
- special recognition in each hero's community*
 *2021 recognitions may be impacted by COVID-19. Alaska Communications will follow state and local guidelines.
