- Hire and evaluate the Superintendent
- Approve the district budget
- Adopt and review curriculum & instructional material
- Develop and adopt policies governing the district

- Study Robert's Rules of Order

- Review your policy manual
 - Start with the Bylaws!
- Ask questions
- Get familiar with the process of reviewing and updating district policies

- NO SURPRISES!






Personal Agendas


Listen

- it will make a difference for kids








