





Our goal is that the AK ESSA plan will support and nourish Alaska's vision of public education.








PERFORMANCE EVALUATION FOR ALASKA'S SCHOOLS

This is NOT a study of the problem.




This IS a process to prioritize the solutions.





Stakeholder Engagement Process



CHALLENGE

 Alaskans submit ideas for topics through an online survey (opened Feb. 1).



Submitted ideas are then categorized by topic.

Alaskans prioritize topics through a second online survey.



 Priority topics, as determined by Alaskans, are assigned to committees.



Committees meet to take public comment, hear presentations, and deliberate.



Committees make final recommendations to the State Board of Education.



 State Board of Education takes public comment and approves final recommendations in a report for Governor and Legislature.


 2 State Board Co-Chairs for each committee

GOVERNOR WALKER'S PLAN FOR A SUSTAINABLE, BALANCED BUDGET

Three necessary elements this year:

- 1. Continue to reduce state spending
- 2. Draw from Permanent Fund earnings to support vital state services and protect the dividend
- 3. Generate more revenue
