### Heidi's WHY for Personalized Learning

Kids grow their confidence as they find their own success rather than constantly being compared to other kids. *They get to focus on their own learning*. Their successes come more quickly because they can focus on themselves and not necessarily on what the person next to them is doing.

- Personalized learning includes blended learning, competency-based learning, culturally responsive teaching, project-based learning, and a focus on incorporating student choice and agency into instructional designs. -Education Elements

- It begins in the classroom.

# Four x Four of Personalized Learning

You do not need technology to personalize. You do need technology to personalized learning at scale.

> The key is how to extend the personalized approach to all students of all abilities.

PL redefines the role of the teacher. <u>Effective</u> teachers are more critical than ever.

- Fairbanks: Danielson Framework
- The transition from the traditional classroom to a PL model is a huge shift for some teachers.

# Four x Four of Personalized Learning

Strong leadership is critical for a strong personalized learning environment.

- The task of the leader is to get his people from where they are to where they have not been.
  -Henry A. Kisenger
- Personalized Learning: Fairbanks #1 Goal
- School Board: Vision and Allocation of Resources
- Superintendent: Systemic Process, Professional Development, Communication, Change Process, Surviving the Pushback
- There is no single right way to personalize learning.
  - Embrace Design Thinking
  - Create a safe environment to TRY and to iterate—teachers, schools, district
  - Fail forward quickly

#### ► Full Day Kindergarten-

- 2018-19 is the first time in the history of Fairbanks that all elementary schools offer fullday kindergarten
