

## Hydaburg City School District CRESEL Action Plan 2018/2019 School Year

The CRESEL (Culturally Responsive Embedded Social Emotional Learning) aims to improve school climate, trauma informed care, co-collaboration, educational learning practices, student and adult social and emotional skills, and academic achievement through integrating culturally responsive values and school-wide positive behavior interventions and supports, and co-creating staff practices.

Self-Management - Managing behavior in effective, constructive ways.

Self-Awareness - Recognizing one's emotions and character strengths.

Social-Awareness - Demonstrating an awareness of the value of others in the greater community

Social-Management - Interacting in a meaningful, productive way with others. Relationship Skills - Building and maintaining healthy, positive relationships with a diverse population and individuals.

Creating a welcoming school environment for families and community. Schedule once a month open house at the school for families and communities that include SEL activities, STEM activities, game night, door prizes, in order for staff, families, community and students to engage together in an informal gathering. Invite parents or community members to teach students and staff cultural language, arts, food prep, subsistence living, and values in the classroom, after school workshops, and teacher inservices. Include a potlatch during parent/teacher conferences and discuss positive strengths of students. Teach students to lead their own conferences. Recognizing a model parent, grandparent, or caretaker each month. Adopt an Elder in the classroom. Classroom teachers and their students will invite an elder to be part of their classroom community to be present and incorporate their cultural values and knowledge in the classroom.
