Our Drafting Process

- With the release of CDC's new guidance for schools on July 9th, our team started to meet and brainstorm.
 - Scheduled a meeting with our local KIBSD Medical Advisory Committee.
 - Drafted our plan and prepared questions for the medical professionals.
 - Sent out a parent survey to get feedback on participation for asymptomatic screening



Mitigations Unique to AGE group



- KIBSD decided to draft our mitigation plans unique to the following age groups:
 Pre-K to 5th grade (Elementary)
 Secondary
 Staff
- Plan to release separate info graphics for each group.

Mitigations unique to KODIAK



- Our mitigation plan takes into account the unique geographic factors of our island as well as the unique factors of our small population.
 - Difficult to assign risk levels based off of the total number of cases
 - 5 rural village schools and additional canary sites that don't affect the risk level of the borough

Asymptomatic Screening Plan



- Recommended for students and staff that are unvaccinated
- Plan to offer families the option of athome testing using the OTC BinaxNOW cards or in school testing using the commercial BinaxNOW cards
- KIBSD will continue to test unvaccinated student athletes as well as any students participating in extracurricular activities before they travel off island.
- KIBSD will consider testing before large indoor gatherings depending on the community risk level.

ASYMPTOMATIC TESTING

Asymptomatic testing is recommended. Please consider participating in KIBSD's asymptomatic screening testing program.

Proof of negative test required prior to travel for KIBSD extracurricular activities (KIBSD will coordinate asymptomatic testing prior to departure.)

CLOSE CONTACT OUARANTINE

OPTION 1: 7-day Quarantine + COVID-19 Negative Test (on day 6 or later) + No Symptoms= Return Day 8

OPTION 2: 10-day Quarantine + No Symptoms= Return Day 11

Additional Requirements for Option #1 and #2:

If you develop symptoms within 14 days of an exposure (regardless of whether or not you remain in guarantine) you should immediately self-isolate and seek testing. If symptoms develop anytime during guarantine, you need to provide proof of a negative test dated after onset of symptoms, report improvement in symptoms, and report you have been fever free for 24 hours to be cleared from guarantine.

UNVACCINATED STUDENTS Asymptomatic testing is recommended. Please consider participating in KIBSD's asymptomatic screening testing program

CLOSE CONTACT QUARANTINE

VACCINATED STUDENTS Do NOT need to guarantine if exposed to someone who has COVID-19

Monitor health and test only if experiencing symptoms

UNVACCINATED STUDENTS OPTION 1: 7-day Quarantine + COVID-19 Negative Test (on day 6 or later) + No Symptoms= Return Day 8

OPTION 2: 10-day Quarantine + No Symptoms= Return Day 11

Proof of negative test required prior to travel for KIBSD extracurricular activities (KIBSD will coordinate asymptomatic testing prior to departure.)

Test up to 48 hours prior to returning to Kodiak or anytime after arrival

If pre-travel/arrival test is negative, individual may return to school, but must wear a mask and strictly monitor for symptoms for 5 days

Follow-up second negative test is required five days after return

Have you received a positive COVID-19 test within 90 days?

The positive test result exempts you from testing or quarantine related to travel or being a close contact.



Secondary

Current Plan:

- Masks recommended for unvaccinated students but optional indoors. Masks mandatory on buses.
- Asymptomatic testing recommended for nonvaccinated students.
- Out of state travel will require testing on or before arrival and 5 days after arrival with strict symptom monitoring & mask wearing for unvaccinated students.
- Option #1 & Option #2 for Close Contact Quarantine for unvaccinated students.



COVID 19^C Staff Protocols

Protocols are subject to change at any time at the discretion of the school district administration, and based on guidance from the CDC, DHSS and local Medical Advisory Committee.

MASK USAGE

VACCINATED INDIVIDUALS Mask not required with proof of vaccination Recommended use for increased safety of self and others

UNVACCINATED INDIVIDUALS Mask required indoors

ASYMPTOMATIC TESTING

VACCINATED INDIVUDUALS Asymptomatic testing is NOT recommended

UNVACCINATED INDIVUDUALS Asymptomatic testing is recommended. Please consider participating in KIBSD's asymptomatic screening testing program

CLOSE CONTACT QUARANTINE

VACCINATED INDIVIDUALS

Do NOT need to quarantine if exposed to someone who has COVID-19 Monitor health and test only if experiencing symptoms

Follow-up second negative test is required five days after return

The positive test result exempts you from testing or quarantine related to travel or being a close contact.

Current Plan:

- Masks optional for vaccinated staff. Masks required for unvaccinated staff indoors.
- Asymptomatic testing encouraged for unvaccinated staff.
- Out of state travel will require testing on or before arrival and 5 days after arrival with strict symptom monitoring & mask wearing for unvaccinated staff.
 - Option #1 & Option #2 for Close Contact Quarantine for unvaccinated staff.



Adjustments in Mitigation as community risk level changes

- One of the most important messages we have as we communicate to families.
- Increase in community spread in our community would change the following:
 - Universal masks for Secondary and Staff
 - Increased asymptomatic testing if possible
 - Transition travel quarantine protocols back to strictly quarantine at home for 5 days.
